- Ph.D. degree in Civil Engineering with specialization in Water Resources Engineering/Hydrology or allied fields (1 No.).
- Ph.D. degree in Civil Engineering/Ecological Science or Engineering/ Environmental Science or Engineering/Biotechnology or allied fields (1 No.)

***Desirable Qualifications:***

- Candidates having working experience in basin hydrology, hydrological modeling, remote sensing, GIS, climate data analysis, pollution load analysis, pollution source mapping, waste, wastewater, solid waste analysis, and treatment.
